**COVID-19 RAPID ANTIGEN TEST**  
Result: NEGATIVE

Sample Type : Nasopharyngeal swab, Method: Chromatographic immunoassay, BRI : Negative

**Interpretations/ Limitations:**

- The gold standard for diagnosis of COVID-19 is RT-PCR.
- The sensitivity of the test is 84.38%. It provides an initial screening test result. Positive results should be considered in conjunction with clinical history and other available data.
- A positive result indicates infection with COVID-19 and does not need reconfirmation by RT-PCR.
- As per ICMR guidelines, this test may be used in the following settings:
  - Containment zones or hotspots:
    - All symptomatic influenza like illness (ILI).
    - Asymptomatic direct and high-risk contacts with co-morbidities of a confirmed case between day 5 and 10.
  - Healthcare settings:
    - All symptomatic ILI patients suspected of having COVID19 infection.
    - All asymptomatic patients who are hospitalized or seeking hospitalization, in the following high-risk groups: patients undergoing chemotherapy, immunosuppressed patients including those who are HIV+, patients diagnosed with malignancy, transplant patients and elderly patients (>65 yrs of age) with co-morbidities.
    - Asymptomatic patients undergoing aerosol generating surgical / non-surgical interventions: elective/emergency surgical procedures like neurosurgery, ENT surgery, dental procedures etc, non-surgical interventions like bronchoscopy, upper GI endoscopy, dialysis etc.
- Symptomatic individuals who test negative for COVID-19 by rapid antigen test should definitely be tested sequentially by RT-PCR to rule out infection.
